Introduction

The Equity in Athletics Disclosure Act requires co-educational institutions of postsecondary education that participate in a Title IV, federal student financial assistance program, and have an intercollegiate athletic program, to prepare an annual report to the Department of Education on athletic participation, staffing, and revenues and expenses, by men's and women's teams. Institutions must submit their EADA data to the Secretary of Education within 15 days of making it available to students, prospective student-athletes, and the public. The sole mechanism for submitting the data is via the EADA Web-based data collection, commonly known as the EADA Survey.

As required, this report is available on Westcliff University's website for current and prospective students. Westcliff University has informed currently enrolled students through electronic mail the summary of the report and a direct link to the publicly accessible web page (https://www.westcliffathletics.com/compliance/EADA_Report). In addition, current and prospective students can contact the university for a paper copy of the report.
